Ordinance # G-08- 23

SUMMER SEWER RELIEF ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA ("GEORGETOWN"), THAT:

WHEREAS, Georgetown Town Council ("Town Council") shall, pursuant to IND. CODE 36-9-23-25, establish just and equitable fees for the services rendered related to sewer works.


WHEREAS, sewer fees have been, and are established, from time to time through ordinances that impose sewer charges, based upon metered water usage, which includes water that does not enter into the sewers for purposes of treatment.

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to limit the metered water usage used to determine sewer charges for residential during the months of June, July, August, and September, and to establish a sewer usage based upon the average water usage of the preceding eight (8) months (October through May) for each customer.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

1. That the average, monthly, metered, water usage shall be determined for existing, residential customers based upon their usage from October through May for each customer account ("Average Use").
2. The water usage used to determine a residential customer's sewer bills for June through September shall be limited to the Average Use established in the preceding eight (8) months for a particular account.
3. That if the actual water usage for June through September is less than the Average Use for a particular customer account, then the sewer bills shall be determined according to such customer's actual usage for such account.
4. That a customer is not entitled to a summer adjustment based upon Average Use, unless he/she has established at least six (6) months of metered, water usage history on his/her own account from the preceding October through May period. Furthermore, account history from a prior customer may not be used to establish the Average Use for an existing customer.


