

Ordinance No. G-98- //

ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PURCHASING AGENTS  
FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF  
GEORGETOWN, INDIANA THAT:

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 5-22 (the "Act") applies to every expenditure of public  
funds by a governmental body;

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown is a governmental body under the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the Town of Georgetown to establish certain  
purchasing rules and policies for the Town;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. The Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is designated as  
the Purchasing Agency for the Town.

SECTION 2. The following individuals are designated as Purchasing Agents and shall be  
responsible for purchasing necessary supplies for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana in  
accordance with the provisions of I.C. 5-22-15-21.


- a) The Deputy Clerk Treasurer shall be the Purchasing Agent for office supplies.
- b) The Superintendent shall be the Purchasing Agent for supplies for the utilities.
- c) The Town Marshall shall be the Purchasing Agent for supplies for the Marshall's  
Department.


Any order made for the purchase of goods costing \$100.00 or more must be signed  
by a majority of the Purchasing Agency.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the  
Town of Georgetown, Indiana that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed


to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
