

ORDINANCE NO. G-98-15

**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO G-93-08
PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT OF PAID
HOLIDAYS FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN
OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AND THE GEORGETOWN
WATER UTILITY AND SEWER DEPARTMENT.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNSEL OF GEORGETOWN THAT:

WHEREAS, the Counsel for the Town of Georgetown is the entity responsible for fixing of compensation, benefits, vacation and sick days for the Town police officers [hereinafter "officers"] and employees, and also the employees of the Georgetown Water Utility and Georgetown Sewer Department;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. G-93-08, provides that the officers and employees of the Town of Georgetown, the Water Utility and Sewer Department have the following holidays off with paid time: New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving Day, Martin Luther King's birthday, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Presidents Day, any general (national, state or ^{Town}~~city~~) election, Christmas Eve day, Christmas, the Fourth of July and Labor day; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to increase the number of paid holidays for the officers and employees of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana and the Georgetown Utility and Sewer Department.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the officers and employees of the Town of Georgetown and the Water Utility and Sewer Department have the following holidays off with paid time: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King's birthday, President's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, the Fourth of July, Labor Day, any general (national,

state or town) election, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving day, Christmas Eve day and Christmas Day.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any portion of Ordinance No. G-93-08 or any other Ordinance of the Town of Georgetown presently in effect, which conflicts with this Ordinance, shall be null and void and be deemed modified in accordance with the resolutions herein; additionally, any portions of any of the aforementioned Ordinances, or any other ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, presently in effect which do not conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance, shall be in full force and effect.






