

ORDINANCE NO. G-99-03

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN RATES
CHARGED FOR WATER UTILITY METER DEPOSITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA
THAT:

WHEREAS, the Board of the Town of Georgetown is the entity responsible for
setting and adjusting rates and charges for usage of the Town's Water Utility.

WHEREAS, the Town currently charges a water meter deposit in the amount of
\$50.00, which amount has been found to be insufficient to adequately protect the
solvency of the Water Utility.


WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion it was agreed that the Water
Utility was in need of an increase in the amount charged for water meter deposits.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that new customers of the Georgetown
Water Utility will be required to pay a water meter deposit in the amount of \$100.00 in
order to obtain water service.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all Ordinances of the
Town of Georgetown, Indiana that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed
to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall
remain in full force and effect.
