

# ORDINANCE NUMBER G-99-011

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON CERTAIN TOWN STREETS.  
WALTS ROAD, KELLY AVE, AND ROY STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that from this day forward, that there will be NO parking allowed on the following streets at any time.

Kelly Ave. between State Road 64 and Walnut Street (northbound or southbound)

Walts Road, between State Road 64 and the railroad tracks (northbound or southbound)

Roy Street, between High street and Alley (unnamed) north of High Street(northbound or southbound)

Due to the narrow width of both of the above stated streets, the town council finds it in the best interest of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana and it's citizens to ordain this ordinance. This comes only after a traffic investigation by the Georgetown Marshal's Department, which concludes that both streets are too narrow to allow on street parking on either side of the streets without obstruction of either northbound or southbound traffic.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON CERTAIN TOWN STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that from this day forward, that there will be NO parking allowed on the following streets at any time.

Kelly Ave. between State Road 64 and Walnut Street (northbound or southbound)

Walts Road, between State Road 64 and the railroad tracks (northbound or southbound)  
*Roy St. between High St. and the unknown alley north of High St.*

Due to the narrow width of both of the above stated streets, the town council finds it in the best interest of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana and it's citizens to ordain this ordinance.

This comes only after a traffic investigation by the Georgetown Marshal's Department, which concludes that both streets are too narrow to allow on street parking on either side of the streets without obstruction of either northbound or southbound traffic.
