Resolution R-09-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CARRIED OVER VACATION FOR IDENTIFIED EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana (hereinafter this "Town Council"), is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, County of Floyd, State of Indiana (the "Town"); and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council is the entity responsible for managing and providing for the management of personnel for the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes that vacations are intended to enhance the employee's well-being and morale, and that such annual vacation leave is required to be utilized with no more than forty (40) hours of vacation carried over from one (1) year to the next, and that carried over vacation must be used before July 1st of each year; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council has identified that three Public Works Department employees have failed to use their 2008 vacation in a timely manner, due to their dedication to the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

The carried over vacation deadline is extended for Public Works Department employees Tim Cooper, Jim Reynolds, and Chad Smith. They are authorized to use their carried over vacation from 2008, prior to December 31, 2009.
