### A RESOLUTION CLARIFYING ORDINANCE # G-07-02, IN REGARDS TO THE 3% PAY INCREASE TO POLICE OFFICERS

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana (hereinafter this "Town Council"), is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, County of Floyd, State of Indiana (the "Town"); and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council is the entity responsible for establishing the compensation of the Town employees pursuant to IC 36-5-3-2; and




**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to pay the town's employees a reasonable and competitive wage while continuing to insure this wage maintains its purchasing power in an ever-changing economy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council desires to clarify an omission in Ordinance # G-07-02, that would increase a Police Officers' salary each successive year with a 3% cost of living wage increase.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Nothing in Ordinance # G-07-02 is meant to imply the Town's Police Officers are to be treated differently then any other employee in regards to the 3% yearly raise, which the Town Council may or may not give to the Town employees.
