## RESOLUTION R -10-10

### RESOLUTION FOR DISCONTINUATION OF BROADBAND SERVICE PURSUANT TO 47 C.F.R. §63.71

**WHEREAS**, the Georgetown Town Council (“Town Council”) conducted a non-surplus property sale for the purpose of disposing of the broadband utility assets and received no qualified offers;

**WHEREAS**, the broadband utility receives insufficient operating revenues to cover expenses, and the Town Council desires to discontinue such services;

**WHEREAS**, wireless internet services are now available through various cellular telephone providers;


**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the Georgetown Clerk-Treasurer and Public Works Director are authorized at the direction of Georgetown’s general counsel to take the following actions:

1. file the application for discontinuation of broadband service with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §63.71;
2. provide notice of termination to all affected customers, as required by 47 C.F.R. §63.71;
3. tender copies of the application to the Secretary of Defense, the Indiana Public Utilities Commission, and the Governor of Indiana, as required by 47 C.F.R. §65.71(a);
4. contingent upon acceptance of the above application by the FCC, terminate Georgetown’s service agreement with Helix Technologies, Inc.;
5. terminate any other agreements required for the operation or provision of services for the Broadband Utility.
