A RESOLUTION FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY BROADBAND EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana (the "Town Council") is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, County of Floyd, State of Indiana (the "Town"); and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown has surplus property related to broadband services, which it intends to authorize for sale, and which is more particularly described in Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, the Town Council hereby adopts this Resolution in order to authorize the sale of such equipment pursuant to IND. CODE 5-22-22-5;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that, pursuant to Ind. Code 5-22-22-5, the Town Council shall:

- 1. sell the property to the highest responsible bidder by sealed bids delivered to the Council before the date of the sale; and
- 2. advertise the sale by publication in Floyd County, Indiana, of the time, place, and terms of the sale;
- 3. notice of the sale shall be published two (2) times, at least one (1) week apart, with the second publication made at least seven (7) days before the date the bids will be received, as provided in IND. CODE 5-3-1(2)(e); and
- 4. the notice shall provide that the surplus property is being sold together and not piecemeal, that the successful bidder must agree to assume all subleases, and the successful bidder shall be required to provide evidence of insurance for purposes of taking possession of personal property held by customers.
