OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA ACTING AS THE
GEORGETOWN SAFETY BOARD PURSUANT TO
INDIANA CODE 36-8-3-4**

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Town Council is, pursuant to I.C. 36-8-3-4 the Georgetown Safety Board; and

WHEREAS, previously the Town hired Theodore Comer as a deputy marshal for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to conduct a hearing to determine whether Theodore Comer should continue to be employed by the Town of Georgetown, Indiana.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


1. That a hearing to determine whether Theodore Comer should continue to be employed by the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is set for the 22ND day of AUGUST, 2013 at 5:00 o'clock P.m. at Georgetown Opt. Mist, Georgetown, Indiana.
2. That the charge against Theodore Comer is incapacity in that Theodore Comer does not have the ability to be a law enforcement officer for the Town of Georgetown because his police powers have been revoked and/or suspended by the State of Indiana.
3. That Theodore Comer has the right to be represented by counsel.
4. That Theodore Comer may call and cross-examine witnesses.
5. That Theodore Comer may require the production of evidence.
6. That Theodore Comer is entitled to have subpoenas issued, executed and served in Floyd County, Indiana.
