Resolution R-17- 2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CARRIED OVER VACATION FOR TOWN EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana (hereinafter this "Town Council"), is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, County of Floyd, State of Indiana ("the Town"); and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council is the entity responsible for managing and providing for the management of personnel for the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes that vacations are intended to enhance the employee's well-being and morale, and that such annual vacation leave is required to be utilized with no more than forty (40) hours of vacation carried over from one (1) year to the next, and that carried over vacation must be used before July 1st of each year; and,


WHEREAS, the Town Council has identified that employees of the Town have failed to use their accrued vacation time by the deadline, due to their dedication to the Town, and their vacation carried over will exceed the forty (40) hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:


