A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN MOVING MONIES FROM THE CUMULATIVE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE CUMULATIVE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT LINE ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the entity responsible to appropriate and otherwise direct the use of the monies of Georgetown, and the Town of Georgetown is a Town chartered in and by the State of Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the local governing board, in accordance with Indiana State Law; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council has identified additional monies that it wishes to expend as a Capital Investment for Fiscal Year 2005, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has approved projects but the budget did not allocate monies for these projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown as follows:

SECTION 1. Cumulative Capital Improvement Fund, #201

\$15,650 of the Cumulative Capital Improvement Fund shall be moved to the General Fund #101 and credited to the Cumulative Capital Improvement Line Item within the General Fund. This money is being transferred to pay for

the purchase and construction of a small 3-sided building to house and protect the Town's road salt (\$4,150), and

to pay for the intersection improvements of Kepley Rd at the intersection with State Route 64, as discussed and planned in 2004 when the vacant land was purchased. (\$2,000 for gravel, \$1,000 for roller rental, \$5,000 for paving and \$3,500 for force labor)

All other classifications within the General Fund remain as currently budgeted.
