A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN AUTHORIZING SEALED BID PROCEDURES TO DISPOSE OF ONE JUNK "VEHICLE"

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the entity responsible to authorize the disposal of equipment/vehicles that no longer have useful life to the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town currently has an old 'bush hog', which has no useful life remaining to the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council now desires to authorize the disposal of this junk vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown as follows:

SECTION 1. DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

The Town Marshal is hereby directed to advertise and conduct a sealed bid for the sale/disposal of the following vehicle:

- a. International Machines 500, 5 foot wide, three point hitch, trail behind mower

All bids are to be accepted on this vehicle "as is, where is" status. Cash or Bank Cashier's check are the only payments to be accepted. It needs to be noted that this trail behind mower was built by cannibalizing a total of four similar mowers in the year 2000. No warranties as to the cohesiveness of this equipment are made.

SECTION 2. REPORTING

The Town Marshal shall host opening of the sealed bids on May 17th, reporting the results back to the Council at the next meeting on May 18th, 2006.
