A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN AUTHORIZING PUBLIC YARD SALE PROCEDURES TO DISPOSE OF SEVERAL ITEMS LEFT IN THE HOUSE AT 5335 OLD GEORGETOWN RD WHEN VACATED BY MRS. ALMA O'BRIEN

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the entity responsible to authorize the disposal of equipment that does not have any useful life to the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town has recently inherited several pieces of furniture and other, smaller items from the purchase of the O'Brien House, which have no useful life to the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council now desires to authorize the disposal of these unusable items – unusable in the conduct of the Town's business but not to residential households.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED
by the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown as follows:

SECTION 1. DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

The Town Manager is hereby directed to advertise and conduct a yard sale in the Town Hall Parking Lot for the sale/disposal of those items abandoned in the house at 5335 Old Georgetown Rd at the time the Town took possession of the house. The Clerk-Treasurer's Staff is requested to assist in the conduct of the yard sale, especially concerning taking payments, making change, etc.

All items are to be sold on a "as is, where is" status. Cash or Bank Cashier's check are the only payments to be accepted.

This Yard Sale shall be held on Friday, August 25th, 2006, from 8 AM until 4:30 PM, in the Town Hall Parking Lot at 9110 SR 64. When the Yard Sale is over, any items that were not sold shall be donated to the Goodwill Industries.

SECTION 2. REPORTING

The Town Manager shall report the sale results back to the Council at their next meeting on September 21st, 2006.
