Resolution # R-06- 14

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN WAIVING THE MONTHLY WATER USE MINIMUMS FOR ANY 1.5" METER WHICH IS SIZED FOR FIRE SPRINKLER PROTECTION ONLY

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the entity responsible for monitoring and controlling the use of public water within the Town of Georgetown, a Town chartered in and by the State of Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council identifies that sometimes certain sizes of water pipes are required in construction of certain facilities in order to insure the public safety of the Town's citizens; and,

WHEREAS, those facilities that had to be built with a 1.5" water meter supply line, in order to properly supply the building's fire prevention sprinkler systems; and,

WHEREAS, as a matter of use, those facilities not routinely use the 20,000 gallon monthly minimum required to be charged for the 1.5 inch sized water meter.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

by the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown as follows:

Effective with the current billing period, any water customer with a 1.5 inch meter, the size of which is required to provide sufficient water flow for fire protection sprinklers to operate in an emergency shall only be charged for the amount of water the account uses; i.e the 1.5" meter minimum water use requirement is waived for those accounts which have a 1.5" meter to meet fire protection standards.




