## Town of Georgetown, IN Resolution R-07- 05

## A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA AUTHORIZING THE REFINANCING OF THE 1998 SEWER BOND ISSUE, AND TAKING OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown refinanced the 1992 Series Sewer Bonds in 1998, in order to save the Town money through changes in the Bond Market; and

WHEREAS, the 1998 Sewer Bonds which the Town currently holds worth a Par Amount of \$2,025,000 have been identified by both Umbaugh & Associates and Hilliard-Lyons as being a money saving value to the Town if those bonds were refinanced in the current Bond Market; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana wishes to save the citizens of Georgetown any money which it is reasonably and prudently possible to save.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows by the Town Council of Georgetown Indiana:
Section 1. The advanced refunding of the 1998 Sewer Bond Issue, in order to save the Town of Georgetown a significant amount of money, perhaps as much as \$100,000 over the life of the Bond Issue, is hereby authorized and approved.  The Town Council is directing the Bond Issue be refinanced by selling the bonds (on the Competitive Market) (to a private investor).
Section 2 is hereby engaged as the Financial Consultant to manage this refunding and refinancing of the 1998 Bond Issue.
Section 3. William Skees, of Frost, Brown, Todd, is hereby engaged as the Bond Counsel for this refunding.
Section 4. Other Actions. The President, the Clerk/Treasurer and other appropriate officials of the Town are hereby directed to take such other actions as may be necessary for the refunding of the 1998 Bond Issue
Section 5. <u>Effective Date.</u> This resolution shall be effective from and after its date of adoption as provided by law.
