A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF GEORGETOWN AUTHORIZING THE
SUBMITTAL OF THE COMMUNITY FOCUS FUND
APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF
COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS AND
ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low- and moderate-income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana has conducted public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the public facilities needs of its low- and moderate-income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana that:

- 1. The Town Manager is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the Town Center Water Line Replacement. The Council President is authorized to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. The Town of Georgetown, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of on hundred ninety thousand, four hundred dollars (\$190,400), in the form of cash on hand as matching funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CFF funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
