A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN TO CLOSE THE PROBATIONARY PERIOD OF A LATERALLY TRANSFERRED POLICE OFFICER, AS A SPECIAL EXCEPTION


WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the entity responsible for providing for the safety and welfare of the citizens of Georgetown; and,

WHEREAS, one manner in which the Town Council protects the citizens of Georgetown is by funding and fielding a Police Department to serve and protect the citizens of Georgetown; and,


WHEREAS, the Town Council acknowledges that when hiring an existing police officer from another agency, AKA a lateral transfer, it does not necessarily require twelve months of observation to determine if the officer is capable of performing the job as a Town Law Enforcement Officer in all situations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown hereby accepts and approves the recommendation of Marshal Larry Potts that Officer Todd Stinson's status as a Probationary Employee be closed and Officer Stinson is hereby identified as having successfully completed his probationary period. This action is a special exception to the Town's normal policy of twelve months of probation for a newly hired police officer, in recognition of Officer Stinson's extensive service with another agency.


