A RESOLUTION IN RESPONSE TO RAMSEY WATER COMPANY, INC. WATER RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, this Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana (hereinafter this "Town Council") is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, County of Floyd, State of Indiana (the "Town"); and,

WHEREAS, this Town Council has recognized that Ramsey Water Company, Inc. ("Ramsey"), has changed their schedule of rates and charges in pursuant of IURC Order in Cause No. 43413, approved June 11, 2008, and

WHEREAS, this Town Council recognizes the impact on the Town of Georgetown to be nominal as the current revenues from Town water charges are sufficient to absorb the cost increases from Ramsey, and


WHEREAS, this Town Council hereby adopts this Resolution in order to maintain reasonable rates to our citizens.
