**A RESOLUTION INTERPRETING AND DEFINING
ORDINANCE G-09-01
THE OVERVIEW OF ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES
AND RULES FOR ELECTED AND OTHER TOWN OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, Ordinance G-09-01 contains certain limitations on the ability to solicit support from Town of Georgetown Employees.

WHEREAS, such limitations are aspirational as they are intended to promote a workplace environment which is free from harassment or coercion and allows employees to perform the duties for which they are compensated without interference or obstruction in the performance of such duties.

WHEREAS, Georgetown does not intend for any language in Ordinance G-09-01 to operate as an unconstitutional restraint on speech.


**NOW BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

The term "solicit" for purposes of G-09-01 shall be defined and limited in application so that it only proscribes those solicitations or communications which are criminal violations as set forth in Ind. Code. 35-44 or Ind. Code 3-14.


