A RESOLUTION TO SELL NON-SURPLUS PROPERTY BROADBAND EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, this Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana (hereinafter this "Town Council") is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, County of Floyd, State of Indiana (the "Town"); and,

WHEREAS, the Indiana Code provides for the disposal of non-surplus utility property pursuant to IND. CODE 8-1.5-2-4 et. Seq.

WHEREAS, this Town of Georgetown has non-surplus equipment related to broadband services, which it intendeds to authorize for sale.

WHEREAS, this Town Council hereby adopts this Resolution in order to authorize the sale of such equipment pursuant to applicable statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: This Town Council resolves to sell non-surplus broadband equipment owned by the Town.

SECTION 2: This Town Council authorizes the appointment of three (3) residents of Indiana to serve as appraisers pursuant to IC 8-1.5-2-4. The appointment of these three individuals shall be made by the town executive.

SECTION 3: Immediately after the appraisal for the non-surplus broadband equipment is submitted to the Town, Notice of a public hearing shall be published in accordance with IC 5-3-1.


SECTION 4: A public hearing on the sale of the non-surplus broadband equipment shall be held no less than thirty-one (31) days after the publication of notice of the hearing and not more than forty-five (45) days after the return of the appraisal.

SECTION 5: If there is no petition objecting to the sale, after the public hearing on the sale of non-surplus property, the Town Council shall pass an ordinance for the sale of the non-surplus broadband equipment pursuant to IC 8-1.5.2-6.
