## RESOLUTION NO. 1992-6

RESOLUTION TO THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AUTHORIZING
THE SUBMITTAL OF THE PLANNING GRANT APPLICATION
TO THE INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE
AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended authorizes the Indiana Department of Commerce to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Department of Commerce, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low and moderate income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana that:

- 1. The Town Council President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to study alternative methods to alleviate excessive storm water drainage problems and its resultant deteriorating effects on public infrastructure improvements in designated areas of the Town. The Town Council President is also authorized to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts, and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Department of Commerce and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 2. The Town of Georgetown, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in an amount of 10% of the total project costs, or up to \$6,000. Said town funds are committed, as the matching share for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon the receipt of Planning Grant funding from the Indiana Department of Commerce.
- 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately.
