CALL TO ORDER

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL

Council members in attendance are Gary Smith, Chris Loop, Patti Denison, Kathy Haller and Jim Tripure. Also in attendance were Richard Stiles, Julia Keibler and Jessica Houghton. Town Attorney Kristi Fox was in attendance as well.

OLD BUSINESS

Summer Sewer Relief Procedure for Edwardsville Water Customers with Georgetown Sewer. Chris Loop did a first reading of Ordinance G-15-17. This is an Ordinance amending Ordinance G-15-08 which is an Ordinance for the rental and use of Bibb Meters. The new Ordinance addresses Edwardsville Water Customers. *Kathy Haller made a motion to approve Ordinance G-15-17. Jim Tripure 2nd the motion. All voted in favor and none were opposed. The Ordinance passed on the first reading.*

Amendment to Ordinance G-15-04. The Ordinance amends Ordinance G-04-13. This will allow the Clerk Treasurers Office to make adjustments to utility bills if there is a discrepancy only with the approval from the Public Works Director. Chris Loop did a first reading of Ordinance G-04-13. *Chris Loop made a motion to approve Ordinance G-15-04. Jim Tripure seconded the motion. All voted in favor and none were opposed. The Ordinance passed on the first reading.*
