**Regular Town Council Meeting**

**Georgetown Town Hall**

**Pledge of Allegiance**

**Roll Call**

Council members present: Everett Pullen, Josh Williams, Kathy Haller, Gary Smith, and Chris Loop. Also in attendance: Ron Stiller, Denny Kunkel, Julia Keibler and Brenton Fender.

**Minutes**

Josh Williams made a motion to approve the minutes for the May 16, 2016 Regular Meeting. Seconded by Kathy Haller and approved 5-0.

Kathy Haller made a motion to approve the minutes for the May 31, 2016 Special Meeting. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 4-0.

**Department Reports**

**Clerk-Treasurer**

Chris Loop made a motion to approve and allow the Council to sign the Community Crossings Grant Match Agreement. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 5-0.

**Georgetown Police**

Chief Denny Kunkel reported that Operation Pullover was very successful in May. Chief Kunkel will be reviewing town ordinances to identify any that are conflicting, flawed, or unnecessary. Chief Kunkel stated that according to Georgetown ordinance the only on street parking allowed in Georgetown is on a specific section of High Street and Walnut Street. Chief Kunkel warned everyone to be alert when driving. The new pavement on Street Road 64 is slick.

**Public Works**

President Pullen stated that when State Road 64 was paved, some of the water shutoffs were covered. It will be Georgetown's responsibilities to uncover these.

**Old Town Hall**

The roofing project at Old Town Hall has been completed. Ron Stiller informed the Council that the roof is warranted for 15 years and should last even longer. Mr. Stiller also stated that the Town should reapply for the grant and consider doing more work on Old Town Hall.

## **Old Business**

Chris Loop made a motion to approve the purchase of a Bobcat skid steer sweeper attachment for \$4,431.83 from MVH. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 5-0.

Chris Loop made a motion to approve \$1,394.00 from sewer the storm water project at 1500 Georgetown-Greenville Road pending a signed waiver from the resident. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 5-0.

Josh Williams made a motion to approve \$3,560.00 from sewer operating to have River City Controls perform regular maintenance on the East and West lift stations. Seconded by Chris Loop and approved 5-0.

Chris Loop made a motion to approve up to \$2568 to repair truck #602. Seconded by Kathy Haller and approved 5-0.

## **New Business**

Richard Lyninger addressed the council regarding parking on the street in Autumn Cove. The council decided to table the issue.

Chris Loop made a motion to give Angela Allen a 6 month average on her March 2016 water bill. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 5-0.

Betty Ervin addressed the council regarding excessive speeding on Kelly Avenue and Nina Drive. She reported that there have been multiple incidents. Betty suggested traffic control devices. The council tabled the issue with plans to involve Bob Woosley in the discussion.

Chris Loop made a motion to approve the Kelly Avenue pay application. Seconded by Gary Smith and approved 5-0.

Josh Williams made a motion to approve \$1,600.00 from water operating and \$5,600.00 from wastewater operating to have Libs Paving complete the Church Alley and Brookstone lift station paving projects. Seconded by Kathy Haller and approved 5-0.

The council decided to table the issue of Mrs. Schladen's failed septic system at 7101 Rainelle Ridge Court.

Chris Loop made a motion to approve the claims docket. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 5-0.

## **Miscellaneous**

The council would like to have Steve Broadus completely fill in the information on his mileage sheets before they approve payment.
