Pledge of Allegiance

Roll Call

Main Street Revitalization Grant Public Hearing

Nick Creevy from River Hills answered question from the public concerning the Main Street Revitalization Grant. The town is requesting \$500,000.00.

Wastewater System

Steve Tolliver informed the council about issues with grease in the wastewater system. Chris Loop made a motion to allow Steve Tolliver to prepare some materials to inform wastewater customers of the issues and proper grease disposal. Seconded by Gary Smith and approved 5-0.

Department and Committee and Reports

Georgetown Police Department

Chief Kunkel informed the council that the new reserve officers have been sworn in.

Public Works

Eco-Tech has started billing the town extra for residential customers generating excessive amounts of trash. Kristi Fox recommended that the council change the language of the ordinance to pass the fees on to the customer.

Chris Loop made a motion to allow the town to purchase \$5,860.00 worth of materials for the Optimist Club drainage project, with the understanding that the Optimist Club will reimburse the town for all costs. Seconded by Kathy Haller and approved 5-0.

Josh Williams made a motion to allow up to \$3,746.00 to purchase lights from Eckhart for Town Hall and the shop. Seconded by Chris Loop and approved 5-0.

Town Attorney

Kristi Fox asked the council if they would like to continue litigation against That's the Ticket. The council decided it would be best to discuss the litigation in an executive session.

Town Engineer

Chris Loop made a motion to allow Everett Pullen to sign the Community Crossings Grant application. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 5-0.

Old Business

Chris Loop made a motion to approve \$7,273.00 to River City Controls for the preventative maintenance agreement for the wastewater lift stations. Seconded by Gary Smith and 5-0.

New Business

Josh Williams made a motion to approve \$1,473.00 for cyber liability insurance. Seconded by Chris Loop and approved 5-0.

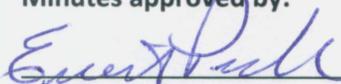
Claims Docket

Chris Loop made a motion to approve the claims docket. Seconded by Josh Williams and approved 5-0.

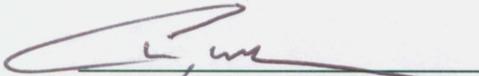
Adjournment

Josh Williams made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Kathy Haller and approved 5-0.

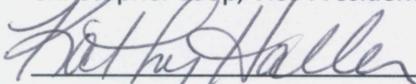

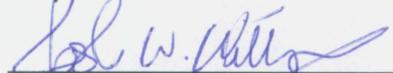

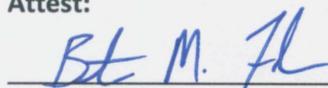
