

TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA
ORDINANCE NO. G-20-06

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL 2% LANGUAGE IN ORDINANCE G-18-04
FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana passed and approved Ordinance G-18-04 on February 20, 2018.

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana desires to repeal language in the Ordinance G-18-04 (an Ordinance Establishing a New Rate for Sanitary Sewer Service Capacity Fees for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana) related to a 2% annual increase on Sewer Service Capacity Fees.

WHEREAS, the Indiana Court of Appeals ruled that the automatic 2% increase provision violates Indiana laws and that it is therefore unenforceable.

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana desires to remove "and thereafter shall increase 2% per year" from Section 1 on Ordinance G-18-04.


WHEREAS, since the 2% provision is not a valid and enforceable rate as a result of the Indiana Court of Appeals decision, a public hearing is not required to repeal this provision.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana that:


1. That Ordinance G-18-04 (an Ordinance Establishing a New Rate for Sanitary Sewer Service Capacity Fees for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana) is hereby amended to remove "and thereafter shall increase 2% per year" from said Ordinance.
2. That the remaining terms and portions of G-18-04 remain in full force and effect.




