**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, a governmental body, would like to have the old bleachers for its use;



**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R-3**

**BY THE CLARKSVILLE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD**

**RESOLUTION TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Clarksville Parks and Recreation Board ("Board") has purchased new bleachers for the softball complex at 961 Potters Lane and has determined that the four (4) sets of old bleachers ("bleachers") are no longer needed and such items are surplus properties; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, a governmental body, has indicated it would like to have the old bleachers for its use;


**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board declares that the old bleachers are surplus property.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the old bleachers may be transferred to the Town of Georgetown for zero cash or property.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the bleachers shall be transferred to the Town of Georgetown upon its passage of a substantially identical resolution.
