## AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE G-17-06, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MAIN STREET FUND

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana no longer wishes to have an Ordinance for the Main Street Fund.

**WHEREAS**, after discussion, review and further consideration, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana desires to repeal the ordinance related to the Main Street Fund within the Town, G-17-06.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

**BE IT ORDAINED** that the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana repeals the Ordinance related to the establishment of a Main Street Fund, Ordinance G-17-06.

**Severability:** If any article, chapter, clause, provision, portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other article, chapter, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance.
