Ordinance No. G-21-

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE OVERNIGHT PARKING ON TOWN PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown;

WHEREAS, The Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana, after review and consideration, has determined that an ordinance should be adopted to restrict overnight parking on Town property.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana it is hereby ordered as follows:

- 1. The Town of Georgetown hereby establishes this Ordinance to regulate overnight parking on Town property.
- 2. No vehicle shall be parked, stopped, abandoned, or otherwise left on Town property, including but not limited to the two Town owned parking lots near Town Hall (adjacent to and across the street from Town Hall at 9111 State Road 64) and Town owned parks, from after 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
- 3. The provisions of all other Town ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof, if any, are no further force or effect and are hereby repealed.
- 4. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
- 5. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and remain in full force and effect and until its repeal by ordinance.
- 6. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Georgetown Police Department.
