- 1) The Georgetown Town Council hereby wishes to sell (3) Brother Printers, Model number MFC-L9570CDW, and containing Serial Numbers SNU64647C7J123422 / SNU64647F7J154632 / SNU64647C7J123433, by internet sale. Said equipment shall be sold as is and no guarantees to the current condition or operability shall be provided. In addition, all sales for these three (3) printers shall require the purchaser to pickup the equipment or pay for any and all shipping costs.

- 3) That a minimum reserve shall be placed on the internet sale of each item at \$50.00 per printer.
